15.30: Building resilience in New Zealand psychologists - a brief summary of a mixed methods research project examining the key variables in resilience. Presentation an approach to clinical supervision which is primarily oriented to wellbeing of the supervisee. The approach is a relational-contextual one where the relationship is central to the supervision, embedded within a network of growth fostering collegial relationships. Stress management, self care and resilience interventions provide the focus of the supervision.
